# FIRE LOCAL RULES (The R&A Rules of Golf Apply)

#### 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18.2)

- a. Beyond any property boundary wall or temporary hoarding / fence on the boundary edge of the golf course.
- b. Beyond any white posts or white lines.
- c. Cart path on the right side of hole 1 and 2 between the golf course and the academy

# 2. Plugged Ball in Bunker

A free drop can be taken when a ball is plugged in a bunker. The ball must be dropped in the bunker, striking the sand within one club length of the plug mark, no nearer the hole. If the ball rolls outside the club length then it has to be played as it lies unless it rolls closer than the original spot in which case it must be dropped again.

### 3. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16)

- a. If a sprinkler head is on your line of play, and within two club-lengths of the Putting Green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball, then the player may take relief under rule 16.1b.
- b. Staked trees or staked shrubs.

### 4. Turf Edge Between Grass Rough and Native (Desert) Areas

If a player's ball lies in a native area, and the turf edge of the grass rough interferes with the ball or the intended swing line, then free relief may be taken. If the player selects to take relief then the ball MUST be dropped in the native (desert) area and cannot be dropped on the grass.

#### 5. Relief from Aeration Holes

If a player's ball lies in or touches an aeration hole on any part of the golf course, relief may be taken under Rule 16.1. See Model Local Role E-4 for further details.

- 6. Golfers Must not Enter a Property to Retrieve a Golf Ball
- 7. Golfers are Requested not to Drive Golf Carts onto the Native Areas
- 8. Ready Golf

It is recommended that you play "ready golf" and make each stroke in no more than 40 seconds.

### 9. Alternative to Stroke and Distance for Lost Ball or Ball out of Bounds

In non-tournament play, when a player's ball has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds, the player may proceed under the Stroke and Distance Local Rule for a penalty of two strokes, rather than proceeding under stroke and distance. This Local Rule is not available if a provisional ball has been played. See Model Local Rule E-5 for full details of the Local Rule.
