

LOCAL RULES

Please note that it is the Golfers responsibility & liability for any damage or injury caused to vehicles, property or individuals whilst playing golf.

1. Moveable Obstruction (Rule 15)

Stones in bunkers are moveable obstructions

2. Abnormal Course Conditions (Rule 16)

All pathways, roadways, sprinkler heads and bridges.
Course furniture, flowers beds, plantations in front of 7th tees & back of 9th green & stone drain below tree line on right side of 8th hole.
Staked trees-one club length relief not nearer the hole. Ground under repair is defined by either (a) GUR Sign (b) Blue Post (c) or areas surrounded by white lines.

3. Penalty Areas (See Rule 17)

Penalty Areas are defined as either red or yellow. This affects the players relief options. (see rule 17)

4. Out of Bounds (Rule 18)

- (a) Beyond any hedge, fence, wall, railings or white stakes forming the boundary of the course.
- (b) New plantations - beyond ant fences as defined by white stakes surrounding the areas 1st, 5th, 6th and 12th holes.
- (c) Environmentally sensitive areas – beyond the line of white stakes to the right of the 11th and 18th holes.
- (d) Beyond the line of white stakes right of the 9th Hole & 1st tee area.

Note: Golfers should not enter these areas to retrieve golf balls

- (e) Car Park and Clubhouse enclosure.

All Fairway distance plates are measured in yards to the front of greens - Par 3's measured to the centre.

Drop Zone on 17th can be used as an option under penalty. (located adjacent to Red Tees.
Defibrillator on Site (Castle & Clubhouse reception)

OnlyRemember the 3 R's:
Repair Plug Marks, **R**eplace Divots and **R**ake Bunkers
