

LOCAL RULES

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.1)**
 - a) Beyond the boundary fence, hedge or wall.
 - b) Beyond the line of white posts
 - c) Over the ditch to the right of the 1st hole
 - d) Beyond the white posts to the right of the 10th hole
 - e) Beyond the internal hedges on the 4th, 5th and 11th holes
- 2. PENALTY AREAS (RULE 17)**

All areas marked by red posts are Red Penalty Areas. Those marked by yellow posts are Yellow Penalty Areas. Dropping Zones must be used where provided.
- 3. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RULE 16.1)**
 - a) Any area marked as ground under repair.
 - b) Any area bounded by white paint.
 - c) All flower beds.
- 4. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 16.1)**
 - a) Staked trees, trees supported by wires.
 - b) All paths and roadways.
 - c) Ground within one club-length of paths and roadways.
 - d) Electricity pylons
 - e) Netting on left of 12th hole
- 5. LOOSE IMPEDIMENTS (RULE 15.1)**
 - a) Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions and may be removed without penalty.
 - b) Any manufactured wood chippings.

- 6. ELEVATED POWER LINES OR CABLES**

If a ball strikes an elevated power line or cable, the stroke must immediately be replayed without penalty. If the ball is not immediately recoverable, another ball may be substituted.
- 7. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS (RULE 16.1)**

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 16.1.

ETIQUETTE AND GENERAL RULES

- a) Keep up with the match ahead, not ahead of the match behind. Please obey Marshals on the golf course at all times.
- b) Please replace all divots and repair all pitch marks.
- c) Where possible, please keep buggies on concrete cart paths.
- d) No trolleys OR buggies within ten yards of greens or tees.
- e) Game to be played in accordance with the Rules and Etiquette of The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews. Players attention is particularly drawn to Section one - Etiquette and the safety issues therein. Any player not aware of Etiquette and Rules may obtain advice from Golf Reception.
- f) Each round of golf should be completed within 4h 30 minutes.
- g) Distance markers are to the middle of the green
- h) 7th tee please wait until the 8th tee is clear before teeing off

GOLFERS PLEASE NOTE

Accidents or Injuries

In the case of an accident or injury, please report to the Golf Reception on 01675 477081.

At all times, be aware of other golfers striking golf balls. The player must play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play guidelines that The Belfry may establish.

Safety

- a) For your own safety, please do not climb steep bunker faces or retrieve balls from lakes.
- b) Do not lick golf balls.
